JOB DUTIES

- Primary worker for a small case load. Responsible for monitoring people supported person centered plans, making home visits to people supported place of residence, maintaining people supported bank account information, refer people supported to appropriate employment or day services, provide supervisor with reports, and maintaining up-to-date documentation as required.
- Help people supported develop their skills and provide training, support and ongoing follow up by working systematically with people supported to attain their goals.
- Prepare meals, assist with light housekeeping, and develop socialization skills
- Liaise with people supported, their families, outside agencies and the general public. Attend meetings as scheduled. To perform other related duties are required.
